

Friday Harbor Labs COVID-19 Prevention Agreement Form

have reviewed the UW Friday Harbor Labs (FHL) COVID-19 Prevention Plan (henceforth The Plan), and understand my responsibilities as an FHL visitor. I agree to follow all rules and procedures in the current version of The Plan, as well as any new COVID-19 prevention protocols that may be implemented after I arrive, for the duration of my stay at FHL. These include requirements for quarantine and testing before and after arrival to FHL. They also include, **but are not limited to**, the following important post-quarantine rules and procedures:

- I will not visit town except for essential services (groceries, other provisions, medications).
- I will not visit restaurants except to pick up take-out meals, and not visit bars.
- Other than essential town visits, I will limit trips off campus to field work and other outdoor excursions, during which I will maintain distance from off-campus island residents.
- I understand that if I depart San Juan County during my stay, I will not be permitted to move back into housing shared with an existing FHL resident (meaning that I may have to rent a separate, free-standing unit for quarantine). I will discuss any such departure with Stephanie Zamora in advance, and Stephanie will determine whether it is possible to accommodate my return to campus. If it is possible, I will repeat the pre- and post-arrival quarantine and testing procedures required for new visitors.
- I will not ride in vehicles, rowboats, or motor boats with anyone who is not a pod member.
- I will wear a face covering inside all FHL buildings other than my housing unit, and outdoors unless alone.
- I will maintain six feet of distance between myself and anyone who is not a pod member.
- I will sanitize before and after using any shared workstations and equipment.
- I will follow any isolation or quarantine procedures deemed necessary in the event of a suspected or confirmed COVID-19 case, as dictated by officials from San Juan County Health & Community Services and the University of Washington Environmental Health & Safety Department.
